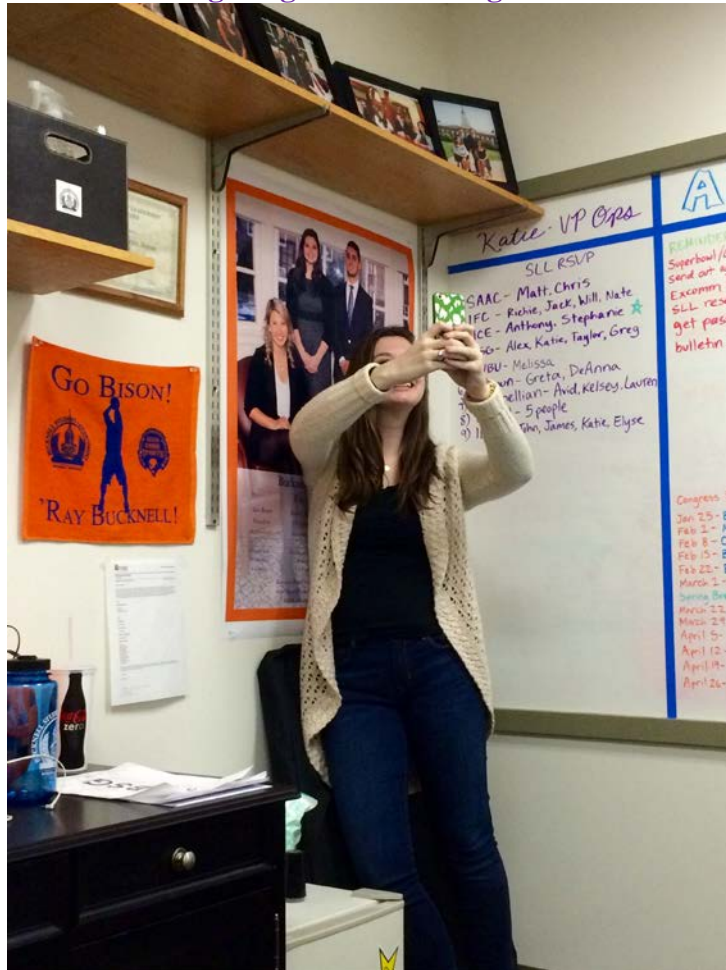
- a. Chief Barilar
